The first of this year's car tours for Friends of the Trust and guests will take place on the afternoon of Sunday May 8th, commencing at Honeybourne at 2.30pm. We will visit three churches, concluding with tea at Throckmorton. Our Chairman and author of "Churches of Worcestershire", Tim Bridges, will give a short talk on the history of each of the churches.

Honeybourne St Ecgwin

Mainly 13th century with Early English chancel.

Some parking adjacent to the church and at the nearby recreation ground. [WR11 7PP]

South Littleton St Michael

Much rebuilt by Frederick Preedy in 1883, incorporating Early English works.

Park in the recreation ground (Football field and Scout hut) the entrance for which is off Long Hyde Road - there is a footpath through to the church. [WR11 8TU]

Throckmorton Chapelry

The church stands almost alone in the fields. A simple building with peaceful atmosphere which reflects its rural status. 13th century with Early English windows and a 15th century belfry.

Parking on the road adjacent to the church and at the nearby Parish rooms - where we will enjoy tea. [WR10 2XJ]
